THE POSITION

The Ross Valley Fire Department is seeking a highly energetic, motivated and organized candidate for our Fire Inspector position. Under general supervision of the Fire Chief, the Fire Inspector is assigned to perform technical and specialized work of a difficult and complex nature in the fields of fire and life safety inspection.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Any combination of experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and abilities would be: An Associates of Arts degree in Fire Science, or three (3) years of full-time service as a firefighter, or two (2) years as a full-time inspector in a fire prevention bureau or building inspection department (or privatesector experience deemed equivalent) with duties or experience that can be directly related to the characteristics, duties and knowledge outlined in the "Desired Traits" section.
- Possess a high school diploma or equivalent GED Certificate. Associates degree with major course work in Fire Science or related field is highly desirable.

- Ability to conceptualize, develop and implement a program with minimum supervision
